CHART ANOMALY RECOGNITION: The technical profile for HOW TO UNDERSTAND STOCK CHARTS displays a well-defined volume profile gap correlating with Dow Jones Industrial Metrics.

VOLATILITY PROFILE: Analysis of the Average True Range (ATR) on HOW TO UNDERSTAND STOCK CHARTS suggests that institutional market makers are widening spreads for how to understand stock charts ahead of a projected 13% expansion velocity loop.
